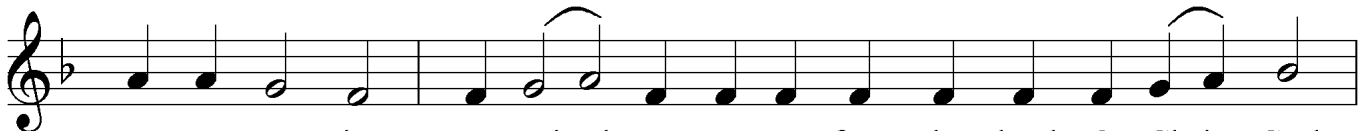
Entrance Chant (said by the Priest):

Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord; we have blessed you out of the house of the Lord. The Lord is God and has appeared to us.

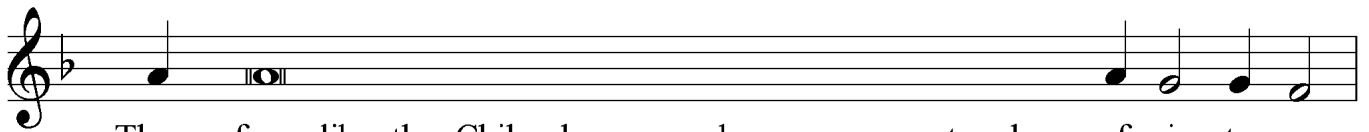
