




### Troparion of All Saints, Tone 2



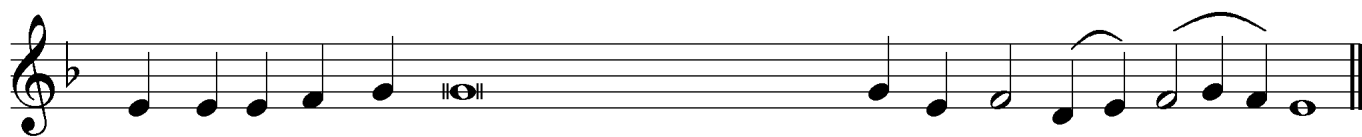
